**Lutz Prep Medical Acknowledgement:**

Please be aware that Lutz Prep **does not** have a nurse on campus during camp hours. All medications that can be taken at home should be administered before or after camp. Lutz Prep will only store **life-saving** medications such as epi-pens and inhalers during camp hours. If your student requires daily medical assistance, intervention, or has a need for a life-saving medication to be stored during camp hours a meeting with the Camp Director must be scheduled prior to your student starting camp. The Camp Director will schedule the meeting with you and all paperwork required will be completed at the meeting with the Camp Director.

**Students will not be permitted to participate in camp until a meeting has been held and all required paperwork is signed and submitted.**

**Payment Policy:**

Upon enrollment, you will receive a total of (3) invoices from QuickBooks Online. The first invoice will cover your registration fee and first week of camp tuition. The second invoice will include any JUNE camps you sign up for with the complete total due 5/22/26). The third invoice will include any JULY camps you sign up for with the complete total due 6/19/26).

**Refund Policy:**

Camp refunds are granted exclusively to families who provide written cancellation notice to [SummerCamp@lutzprep.org](mailto:SummerCamp@lutzprep.org) at least 7 days prior to the scheduled camp start date. While there is no penalty for cancelling a single week of camp within this timeframe, a \$35 administrative fee will be deducted from the refund for every additional week cancelled thereafter. *For example, cancelling three weeks of camp would result in a total administrative deduction of \$70. There are no exceptions to these requirements.*

Please note that all eligible refunds are processed collectively during the final week of camp, beginning July 27th, 2026. Alternatively, if you provide the required 7-day notice, you may choose to apply your payment toward another available week of camp in lieu of a refund.

**Medications:**

I understand medication will only be given to my child when the proper authorization form is completed by a parent or guardian. Prescription medication must be in original containers with prescription labels and must be prescribed for the specific child consuming the medication. Sample medications from doctors must be accompanied by a written prescription from the doctor. Dosages must coincide with the label unless the doctor’s note specifies differently for both prescriptions and over the counter medicine. A scheduled meeting with the Camp Director must take place prior to the child’s first day of attendance in order to verify appropriate completion of paperwork and review directions for administering medications. Please note, we are unable to accept medications during carline times. Medication cannot be sent in a child’s backpack and must be handed to the Camp Director.

I understand that I must pick up any medications from the Summer Camp Director on the Friday of the last day of camp for my student. I understand that any medications not picked up from camp by **JULY 24th** will be destroyed as required by the district policy.
